- 6. Principal's Report & Business Arising from Report: Jennifer Keene
  - We have 9 classes this year with a total of 212 students: JK/SK, SK/1, Gr. 1, Gr. 2, Gr. <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub>, Gr. <sup>4</sup>/<sub>5</sub>, Gr. <sup>5</sup>/<sub>6</sub>, Gr. 6/7, Gr. 8
  - New staff members: Ms. O'Reilly Gr. <sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub>, Ms. Boles (Educational Assistant), Mrs. Connolly (Office Assistant), Myself- (new principal)
  - Students are adjusting to being back at school
  - Grade 7 and 8 students will continue the tradition of "Lunch Out on The Town" on Tuesday, Wednesday and Fridays
  - Struggling to find noon hour monitors- this is a paid position 1 hour/day (11:30-12:30)
  - 2 new policies this year to share with CSAC: Code of Conduct and Educational Field Trips (share Code of conduct for Students and Parents)
  - Late summer we had painting of the lines completed: Thank you to CSAC for cover the cost for this
  - Opening Mass is Thursday September 21st at 10am
  - Open House: Thursday September 28th @5:00-6:30
  - Elementary Sports Council- Transportation will be giving Holy Name \$900.00 to help cover the cost for sports/extra-curricular activities related bussing this year
  - Intermediate school play will take place this Fall: Beauty and the Beast- auditions have been held
  - Thank you to CSAC for covering the cost of painting the lines- we received the bill of \$6215.00 and will pay it this week from CSAC money

#### **Business Arising from Report:**
